

## **iPad's In The Classroom**

- You must first have the iPad on hand and turn it on with the black button on top
- Once you turn it on, you will be taken to the “home” screen. This is where you can find all of the applications that are necessary for completing classroom activities.
- The application center can also be found on the home screen. The application center is home to thousands of applications that are offered for free or there are also ones that require you to pay.
- Once you are able to get to the application center, you are able to choose what application is suitable for each child or your classroom as a whole
- Say I would like to purchase Math Evolve, which is designed for kindergartners-second graders. To do so I would search for the application in the search bar or go to one of the many categories.
- There are categories for weather, lifestyle, sports, education, etc. For this game I would click on the education tab. This tab will pull up all of the applications that are related to education.
- To find this application easier, I would search for Math Evolve in the search part of the application center. You then would click on “install” for the application to become available to you.
- Once you have clicked install, you are required to enter an Apple ID and a password. This is something you have to create in order to access all of the applications that are available.
- After your ID and password has been entered, you are then able to download the application to the iPad.
- When the application is done downloading, you are able to access it at any time.
- You would just touch on the touch sensitive screen on the designated application.
- The introduction to the application, as well as instructions on how to use the application will pop up in the beginning. This shows you what you need to do in order to play the educational related games as well as any help you need in needing.
- From here you are able to use the application as many times as you want!
